	No paving or other works have been completed on the lot near the boundary lines prior to fencing being installed.
	If paving is completed before installation, the lot owner is aware our contractors do not re-lay any paving or 'cut in' to paving. This needs to be done after fencing is installed.
IMPORTANT — Landowner's Responsibilities	
I (Owner) agree that the boundaries on my lot are fully accessible and are free from any obstructions, including but not limited to: paving, building rubble, rubbish, unlevelled sand piles etc. If the boundaries are not clear, I understand my fencing will not be installed until it is fully cleared, even if this occurs after my occupancy date. If paving or any other form of landscaping occurs before fencing is installed, our contractors are not liable for re-laying anything that needs to be removed for the installation of fencing (as per your contract, all boundaries must be fully clear for installation).
